Introduction

Reports To:

Integrated Biometrics (IB) provides a suite of world-class biometric products ranging from touchless identification software, middleware solutions to embedded and portable FBI certified fingerprint devices that are used around the globe. We are seeking a highly experienced and dedicated professional to join our team as a Senior Controller.

Based on the candidate's level of experience and qualifications, there is potential for consideration for a higher job title such as Vice President of Finance or Chief Financial Officer (CFO). Candidates with exceptional expertise, extensive leadership & operations experience, and a proven track record in financial management may be considered for these elevated positions.

Job Purpose

The Senior Controller manages all areas and responsibilities of Accounting, Financial Reporting and Operational Reporting. The Senior Controller reports directly to the Chief Executive Officer.

The Senior Controller is responsible for the accounting operations of IB, to include the timely accurate production of financial reports, maintenance of accounting records and controls and reporting variances versus budgets to provide guidance to management. The Senior Controller will ensure that reported results comply with generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP).

The Senior Controller is responsible for cash monitoring, forecasting and management. This includes providing notice for funds received from customers, monitoring spending activities versus P-Plan and maintaining a 13-week cash forecast, updated weekly.

The Senior Controller will also oversee A/R credit checks, collections, customer payment terms, and management of past due accounts. The Senior Controller has the authority to notify the customer and sales department of A/R policy / terms violations and to put customer shipments on hold and adjust A/R terms with customers if appropriate for good A/R risk management.

With regards to A/P, the Senior Controller is encouraged to make maximum use of AP terms, and to recommend / negotiate improvements to A/P terms where possible.



Typical work includes:

Management Responsibilities

- Maintains and administers accounting policies and procedures
- Define, monitor, and achieve the department's quarterly ROCKS (goals)
- Direct and manage the finance and accounting team
- Monitor the accounting operations of IB Korea, focused on timely and accurate transactionprocessing and adherence to accounting policies and procedures
- Support and participate in development of the company's quarterly P-Plan (financial plan), to include departmental-level information and metrics
- Provide monthly analytics and reporting for variance to P-Plan at the Consolidated, Individual Company and Departmental levels.

Transaction Responsibilities

- Monitor the accounts receivable and accounts payable functions
- Process IBUS payroll
- Ensure that month end closings are completed per schedules
- Ensure that required payments are made on a timely basis
- Maintain the chart of accounts
- Maintain a system of controls over accounting transactions, to include separation of duties

Reporting Responsibilities

- Issue timely and accurate financial statements and budget variances for IBUS, IBK and the consolidated company
- Recommend scorecard metrics to measure and improve the performance of company operations
- Calculate and report financial and operating metrics to key stakeholders within the company
- Monitor and report variances from the P-Plan, reporting significant variances to management
- Develop, monitor and report P-Plan variances to departmental leaders
- Assure timely close of financial books each month.
- Provide financial analysis as needed for capital investments, pricing decisions, project investment reviews, contract negotiations and other efforts
- Analysis and reporting of company sales and operations planning (SIOP)
- Monitor, analyze and report the 13-week cash forecast for the Company
- Other reporting, as defined, and as required for 3rd parties



Compliance

- Coordinate the provision of information to external auditors
- Develop and implement transaction auditing processes for IB activities
- Monitor and report debt levels and compliance with debt covenants
- Comply with local, state, and federal government reporting requirements and filings
- Comply with other reporting requirements (investor, lender, other)
